Topic	Friends of Carnegie Library / Carnegie Library Association	Carnegie Community Trust
Basic aim	Reinstatement of the library together with the previous income-generating and community uses, plus additional uses compatible with a library.	Marginalisation of the library in the hope of someday obtaining grants for running the building on the basis that it is not a library.
Constitutions	Membership organisations electing committees/trustees annually.	Paternalistic foundation without a membership. (The constitution provides for Associate Members but these would not have any voting or other rights)
Business Plan development	In conjunction with the community, through questionnaires and public meetings.	No community involvement.
Completed Business Plan	Published on the Friends' website	Not published
Basement Gym	Opposed by the Friends	Originally proposed through one of CCT's predecessors set up by Lambeth councillors and subsequently supported by CCT.
Response to GLL's Planning Application for the use of the whole building as a gym	Opposition at the pre-application stage of the Planning application and subsequently.	Silence.
